3. Whether the defendant Nos.2 to 8 prove that, the partition has already taken place in between father of defendant Nos.6 and 8 i.e., Rudrappa and his brother Erappa in the year 1975 in respect suit schedule properties ?
4. Whether the defendant Nos.2 to 8 prove that, the father of 1st plaintiff and defendant No.1 and grandfather of 2nd plaintiff Sri. Erappa has sold property allotted to his share in the partition to one Channabasavva W/o: Chikkappa Jyoti ?
5. Whether the defendant Nos.2 to 8 further prove that, the suit of the plaintiffs is barred by law of limitation?
6. Whether the suit is properly valued and court fee paid is sufficient?

7. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, they are entitled for $\frac{1}{2}$ share each in the plaint A schedule properties ?
