1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that plaint 'A' schedule property is the ancestral joint family property of themselves and defendant Nos.1 to 4 ?
2. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the compromise decree passed in OS No.53/2002 dtd: 19-01-2002 is not binding on their share ?
3. Whether the defendant Nos.1, 2 and 4 prove that, suit of the plaintiffs is barred by law of limitation ?
4. Whether the defendant Nos.1, 2 and 4 prove that, the suit of the plaintiffs for declaration of the compromise decree is null and void is not maintainable ?
5. Whether the defendant Nos.1, 2 and 4 prove that, by virtue of the compromise decree passed in OS No.53/2002 the father of the defendants by name Ningappa become the absolute owner of the suit 'A' schedule property ?
6. Whether the suit is properly valued and court fee paid is sufficient ?
7. Whether the plaintiffs are entitle for the relief of declaration as prayed for ?
8. Whether the plaintiffs are entitle for the relief of partition and separate possession of their shares in

plaint 'A' schedule property as prayed for ?

9. What order or decree ?
