The parties further stated that, the matter is settled amicably and they prayed that decree may be passed in terms of mediation report.

Perused the mediation report with compromise petition/ agreement, relationship of parties and nature of the suit. The contents of Compromise Petition are read over and explained to the parties. The parties have understood and admitted that the contents of Compromise Petition as true and correct and on examination by

the Court, it is stated by the parties that they are entering into compromise with free will and there is no any compulsion, coercion or fraud of any kind from anybody.

The parties have admitted the terms and conditions of compromise petition/ mediation report. On perusal of the Compromise Petition and on examination of the parties, it appears that the parties are compromising the matter with their free will and voluntarily.

Therefore, I proceed to pass the following:

The Mediation report along with agreement filed under Order XXIII Rule 3 of C.P.C. is hereby allowed.

The Suit is disposed of in terms of mediation report.

Draw final decree accordingly.

The mediation report, agreement/compromise petition shall form part and parcel of compromise decree.
