Case called out. Accused present.

Sri. NCH, advocate files vakalat for accused and files application u/s 275 of BNS.

The accused submits that, he wants to plead guilty of the offences alleged against him. The consequences of pleading guilty is explained and accused pleaded to convict him with fine. His pleading guilty is voluntary one. Hence, I proceed to pass the following.

### **ORDER**

Application filed U/sec 275 of BNSS is hereby allowed.

Accused is convicted for the offence p/u/sec 281, 125(a) and 125(b) of BNS.

The accused is sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs.500/-** for the offence p/u/sec 281 of BNS and in default he shall undergo SI for **10** days.

The accused is sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs.1,000/-** for the offence p/u/sec 125(a) of BNS and in default he shall undergo SI for **10** days.

The accused is sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs.1,500/-** for the offence p/u/sec 125(b) of BNS and in default he shall undergo SI for **10** days.

Total fine of **Rs.3,000/-**.

Office is directed to receive the fine amount.

The vehicles seized in this case are hereby absolutely released in favour of RC holder subject to production of copies of the Insurance, Emission Test Report and LLR or DL of accused and RC holder.

Case stands disposed off.
