Cross examination by Sri. RAJ for Sri.MSA Counsel for R-3:

I am uneducated. I have documents to show my date of birth and I have produced the same in this case. It is incorrect to suggest that, my present age is more than 65 years. I know the contents of my evidence affidavit. According to me the accident occurred because of the negligence on the part of the driver of tipper lorry.

It is true to suggest that, as per Ex.P. 6, the accident occurred on mud / kacha road. It is incorrect to suggest that, in Ex.P. 7, the place of accident is wrongly shown.

At the time of accident, I was proceeding towards Basavapura. I have documents in respect of the said bike in which I was traveling. I have DL to ride the said bike. I have no hurdles in producing the copy of my DL. It is incorrect to suggest that, the said accident occurred because of my own negligence and not negligence on the part of driver of tipper.

I am agriculturist. I have documents to show that I possess agriculture land and already I have produced the same. It is incorrect to suggest that, I am deposing false about my age, occupation, and income. Even now also, I used to my agriculture land and also dealing the business of sugar cane. I am discharging my all regular works, as earlier I was. It is incorrect to suggest that, I am deposing false that I am having disability and facing difficulties in discharging my day to day regular work.

It is true to suggest that, no operation was conducted while giving treatment. It is incorrect to suggest that, in order to claim more compensation, I have got created all the medical bills and produced. There is no nexus between the medical bills produced and the alleged accident and injuries. I do not know whether as on the date of accident, the insurance policy of the said Tippar lorry was not in force. It is incorrect to suggest that, as the insurance policy was not in force, the 3rd respondent is not liable to pay compensation.
