	<u>01.12.22</u>	The anticipatory bail petition dated 06.10.22 filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely Ramanand Sharma who is apprehending his arrest in relation to Devipur P.S. Case No. 96/2022, registered under Sections 379, 411/34 of Indian Penal Code is taken up for hearing. It has been submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner that he had committed no offence whatsoever as alleged in the written report. Learned counsel further submits that there was a deal between transporter and proprietor of M/s Rajgiri Singh and the transporter had hired the truck of petitioner bearing Reg. No. NL 02N 9414 and therefore he has no concern at all with the alleged occurrence. Therefore, having placed reliance upon submission made herein above, it is submitted that accused petitioner may be admitted on anticipatory bail. Learned P.P. vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail and submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and 100 pieces of iron-pipes were seized from the truck of petitioner, hence the petition filed on his behalf is fit to be rejected. Consequent upon rival submission a careful perusal of record makes it clear that on 19.06.22 at about 2.30 A.M., the informant being Project Manager of M/s Rajgiri Singh working in Nal-Jal Yojna at Devipur block, received information from villagers regarding stealing of pipe from pipe yard, rushed there and informed the police. The police also reached there and found several vehicles engaged in stealing of pipes from yard. After seeing the police, many miscreants fled away from there but some of them were arrested. The	

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	Contd..2 01.12.22	police seized several vehicles including truck of petitioner bearing Reg. No. NL 02N 9414 loaded with 100 pieces iron pipe. Driver of the truck was arrested who disclosed the fact that the petitioner is owner of the vehicle who fled away after seeing the police. From perusal of written report, it is evident that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and he is alleged to be owner of vehicle over which 100 pieces stolen pipes were seized. It is also evident that the petitioner fled away from place of occurrence after seeing the police. From perusal of Para 13 of case diary, it is evident that the police found the case true against the petitioner under Section 379/411/34 of Indian Penal Code. The case is still under investigation and many facets of the case are yet to be disclosed. Hence, under given circumstances, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly the anticipatory bail petition filed on his behalf stands rejected.
