**I S S U E S**

- 1) Whether the plaintiff proves that, suit properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of himself and defendants?
- 2) Whether the plaintiff proves that, himself and defendants are in joint possession and enjoyment of the suit properties?
- 3) Whether the plaintiff proves that, no partition taken in the suit properties between himself and defendants by metes and bounds?
- 4) Whether the defendant No.1 and 3 proves that, the suit of the plaintiff suffers from non joinder of necessary parties ?
- 5) Whether the defendant No.1 and 3 proves that, there was a partition between all the four brothers in the suit properties by metes and bounds?
- 6) Whether the defendant No.1 and 2 prove that, the plaintiff partitioned with his two sons in R.S No. 123/2A i.e., suit property 2H, R.S No. 124/2 i.e., suit property 2J and R.S No. 124/7 and western portion of the house on 20-01-2016 by way of registered partition deed before, the Sub Registrar office, Savanur ?
- 7) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for 1/4th share in the suit properties ?
