File taken up today on 4<sup>th</sup> application U/s. 483 BNSS for grant of regular bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Vijay Kuhad @ Sardarji**.

Reply to the above said application has been filed by IO. Same is taken on record. Copy of the same supplied to Ld. counsel for applicant/accused.

Ld. counsel for applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused is in JC since 11.02.2024 and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that applicant/accused was not named in the present FIR nor involved in the present offence in any manner or in any other criminal case. It is further submitted that alleged recovery of arms which is one pistol .30 bore (with bursted barrel) and one desi katta with 02 live rounds is shown effected from the possession of applicant/accused as same are being planted by the police. It is further submitted that investigation in the present case is already completed qua applicant/accused and charge-sheet has already been filed. It is further submitted that all the prosecution witnesses are police officials and there is no public witness in the present case. It is further argued that no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the applicant/accused behind the bar. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be allowed.

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On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Briefly stated, the present FIR bearing no. 37/2024 has been registered at PS Crime Branch U/s.186/353/307 IPC & U/s. 25 (1) (AA)/27 Arms Act. Perusal of the FIR shows that specific allegations have been leveled against applicant/accused **Vijay Kuhad @ Sardarji** and he has actively participated in commission of alleged offence. As per the reply filed by IO, illegal arms and ammunitions recovered from the house of applicant/accused **Vijay Kuhad @ Sardarji**. Further, applicant/accused is a member of the dreaded Kala Jathedi/Priyavart Kala. Further, applicant/accused is involved in supplying illegal arms/ammunitions to gangsters on instructions of gang kingpins.

Keeping in view of seriousness of allegations and also considering the seriousness and gravity of the offences alleged against applicant/accused namely **Vijay Kuhad @ Sardarji** this court is not inclined to grant bail to applicant/accused namely **Vijay Kuhad @ Sardarji** . The present bail application stands dismissed, accordingly.
