ORDER ON IA No.I

The plaintiff has filed this application U/Sec.80(2) of CPC by praying to permit him to exempt with the statutory notice to the defendants and to permit him to institute the suit.

The plaintiff has sworn in an affidavit accompanying with IA No.I, wherein he stated that himself has filed this suit for declaration of name and mandatory injunction against the defendants and for other reliefs. Further, the Applicant submits that there is urgency on part of the plaintiff to institute a suit without waiting for statutory time of giving mandatory notice to the defendants, as to apply for the KSRTC Driver job.

On perusal of plaint, affidavit and documents, I am satisfied with the reasons assigned therein. The plaintiff is seeking for declaration of his name. He is intended to apply for job in KSRTC. Therefore, at this juncture it is necessary to dispense with issuance of mandatory statutory notice to Defendants, otherwise the very purpose of filing the suit would be defeated. Therefore, this court is of the view that, at this stage, the plaintiff has made out a case to permit him to institute the suit by dispensing with the statutory notice to be caused to the defendants. Therefore, this Court proceed to pass the following,

ORDER

The IA No.I filed U/Sec.80(2) of CPC filed by the plaintiff is hereby allowed.

The issuance of notice U/Sec.80(1) of CPC to defendants is hereby dispensed.

Plaintiff is permitted to institute the suit by dispensing the mandatory statutory notice to Defendants.

Office is hereby directed to institute the suit.
