

Case called out before Lok-Adalath. Both Counsels and all parties are present. Heard on joint memo of settlement.

The contents of the joint memo of settlement has been read over to the parties and explained to them. On enquiry plaintiff and defendant submits that, they understood the contents of joint memo. Parties have stated that they have voluntarily compromised the matter in order to put an end to the litigation and safeguard their relationship. The parties prays to decree the suit in terms of joint memo. Hence, Court is in the opinion that the compromise is not entered into duress or pressure. It has been entered into on their volition and voluntarily. As such, there is no any legal prohibition for this compromise. The compromise is to be accepted and final order is to be passed in terms of joint memo. Hence, Court proceed to pass the following.

ORDER

The joint memo filed by the parties for settlement is accepted subject to scope of the suit and parties are hereby directed that to register the said decree before the jurisdictional sub registrar office.

The joint memo forms the part of the decree.
