

Misc. Crl. Applications No. 1688/2022

(Madhupur P.S. Case No. 199/2022)

A surrender cum bail petition along with fresh Vakalatnama has been filed on behalf of the accused/petitioner namely **Chunchun Pandey** through his learned lawyer. Copy of the same has been served upon the learned A.P.P.

The learned lawyer of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence under law. The petitioner has not filed any bail petition before any superior court prior to this one. The accused/petitioner has been implicated in the instant case with a view to harass him. The petitioner has already deposited loss amount to the Electricity Department. It is, therefore, prayed that the accused/petitioner may kindly be released on bail.

Heard and perused the case record. On perusal, it transpires that the instant F.I.R. has been lodged as Madhupur P.S. Case No. 199/2022, U/s 135 of the Indian Electricity Act on the basis of the written report of the informant Rahul Kumar Vishwakarma, J.E.E., Electricity Department, Deoghar. Alleged sections against the accused/petitioner is non-bailable but compoundable in nature and petitioner namely **Chunchun Pandey** has already deposited fine amount of Rs 30,660/- vide receipt no. 502572 dt. 31.08.2022 and he has received no dues certificate from the Electricity Department. The petitioner has shown original receipt and no dues certificate and submitted xerox copy of document. Hence, the above named accused/petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs 5,000/- with one surety of like amount each.
