The present case has been received today in this court. Office has put its report. As per office report there is no objection. Complaint be registered.

Preliminary evidence has been recorded in the court. Complainant has closed the preliminary evidence.

Heard on the point of summoning of accused. Complainant has filed the present complaint against the accused under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act on the ground that the accused in discharge of his existing liability, had issued a cheque for **Rs.213195/- dated 04.08.2022 Ex. C2** in favour of the complainant. On presentation, said cheque was dishonoured by the bank with remarks **“Refer to Drawer”**. Thereafter, a legal notice was issued and the same was sent, but the accused had failed to make the payment of the cheque in question. Hence, this complaint.

In view of the evidence and documents as discussed above, there are sufficient ground to proceed against the accused for the commission of offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. Let, the accused be summoned for the commission of offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act for **09.01.2023**. Special summons through ordinary process as well as through whatsapp be issued to the accused accordingly. Steps be taken within seven working days. Complainant is at liberty to effect the service of summons upon accused through e-mail also as per law.
