I S S U E S

1. Whether the petitioners prove that, on 19.05.2019 at about 2.30 A.M., when the deceased by name Ajaya was traveling in a motor cycle on bearing No.M.H-24 B.D- from Narangawadi to Madansuri in NH-548, at that, time a rider of Motor cycle bearing No.KA-32 H-5526 came in a rash and negligent manner and high speed and dashed to the motor cycle of deceased and thereby caused accident, due to which, the deceased was sustained grievous injuries and died in a hospital ?
2. Whether the petitioners prove that, they are the legal heir of the deceased Ajaya S/o Shahuraj Gaikwad ?
3. Whether the respondent No.2 proves that, the rider of respondent No.1 motor cycle bearing No.KA-32 H-5526, was not having valid and effective driving license, as on the date of accident and the respondent No.1 has violated the terms and conditions of the policy and not insured his vehicle, as such, its company is not liable to pay compensation to the petitioners ?
4. Whether the petitioners are entitled for compensation? If so, what is the compensation amount and from whom ?

5. What order or award ?
