

**IN THE COURT OF II ADDL. SENIOR CIVIL
JUDGE & MACT, KALABURAGI.**

BEFORE LOK ADALAT

Case called before Lok Adalath.

Petitioner is present.

Respondent No. 2 absent.

The counsel for the petitioner and respondent No. 2 have filed Joint Memo stating that, petitioner and respondent No. 2 have settled their dispute for a sum of Rs. 17,55,000/- towards full and final settlement. The terms of Joint Memo have been read over and explained to petitioner in the language known to her. She accepted the same as true and correct. On inquiry petitioner submitted that, she has entered into compromise out of her own volition and there is no compulsion on her. The intending compromise appears to be voluntary. Accordingly, this tribunal proceeds to pass following:

ORDER

Joint Memo filed by the petitioner and respondent No. 2 is accepted/ALLOWED.

Respondent No. 2 shall pay an amount of Rs. 17,55,000/- to petitioner within specified time.

Having regard to the nature of injury and quantum of amount agreed it would be just and necessary to release entire amount in favor of petitioner.

The amount shall be disbursed as per the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble High Court in MFA No.2509/2019 (ECA) and as per General Circular No.2/2019 dated: 19-08-2019, after collecting Pan card/ Aadhaar card and bank account particulars.

In view of the memo filed by the petitioner, petition against respondent No.1 is dismissed.

Draw award accordingly.
