**Order on application filed by
the Plaintiff U/o 7 Rule 14(3) of
CPC**

The plaintiff has filed this application U/O 7 rule 14 (3) of CPC to condone the delay of production of documents and permit him to mark the above documents by allowing the application in the interest of justice and equity.

On the other hand defendant counsel for defendant has filed objection to the application.

Perused, objection filed by the defendant counsel, which is formal in nature and if an opportunity is given to the plaintiff, no loss or hardship will cause to the defendant. Moreover, mere marking of the document is not a proof and the court has to give a label to that, documents and even the defendant counsel every liberty to cross examine the witness with regard to above document and also object for marking the above documents. Furthermore, if

the application is allowed by imposing reasonable costs, it would suffice the objection raised by defendants. Hence, I proceed to pass following.

ORDER

The interim application filed by the plaintiff U/O 7 Rule 14 of CPC is hereby allowed on of costs of Rs.200/-.

The plaintiff is permitted to produce the documents annexed with list and mark the same, subject to proof and relevancy and payment of costs.
