

Heard the learned Advocate for plaintiff. Perused the materials on record. On perusal, it reveals that the plaintiff has filed the present suit for Declaration and Mandatory Injunction against the defendants. The plaintiff has also filed I.A.No.I Under Order XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 of C.P.C and sought an exparte ad-interim order of temporary injunction to restrain the defendants No.1 to 6 from interfering into the suit property, till the disposal of the suit.

Perused the averments of the plaint, I.A.No.I, affidavit and the documents produced in support of I.A.No.I and taking into consideration. The nature of the suit property the nature of the relief sought in the suit and sought in the application, the Court opines that the plaintiff has filed suit against the defendants for Declaration and Mandatory Injunction and also claiming exparte temporary injunction against the defendants. Hence, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, at this stage, based on the available materials on record, the plaintiff has made out a prima facie ground for grant of exparte temporary injunction order against the defendants No.1 to 6. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The defendants No.1 to 6 are hereby temporarily restrained from interfering into the suit property, till next date of hearing by way of granting exparte temporary injunction order.

This exparte temporary injunction order will be in force till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff had to comply the provisions of order 39 Rule 3 R/w 151 of C.P.C.

Issue Notice of I.A.No.I and suit summons to the defendants No.1 to 6 and suit summons to defendant No.7 to 9.
