ORDER

This is Petition U/sec.13(3) of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act 1969.

2. The case of the petitioner in brief is as under:

Petitioner is permanent resident at Shrichand Village, Tq: Aland, Dist: Kalaburagi Now present Tq. Kamalapur and at the time of his birth his family members residing in Shrichand Village, Tq: Aland, Dist: Kalaburagi. Now present Tq. Kamalapur Further stated that he was born on 12-10-1965 at Shrichand Village, Tq:

Aland, Dist: Kalaburagi. Now present Tq. Kamalapur Due to oversight, the said event was not registered in the register of Births and Deaths maintained by the Respondent. Now he needs the Birth certificate obtaining for Land Mutation and Govt. benefits. He applied to respondent for issuance of birth certificate. But he issued endorsement stating the non-entry of his birth in the concerned register. Hence, this petition.

3. Notice of the Petition was served to the Respondent. But he remained absent. Hence, he was placed ex.parte.

4. Petitioner in order to prove his case has examined himself as PW-1. He produced documents which is marked as Ex.P1 to 2.

5. Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the materials on records.

6. On the basis of the assertions of Petitioner, the following points arise for consideration:

1. Whether the petitioner has made out grounds to allow the petition as prayed for ?

2. What order?

7. The answer to the above said points are as under:

REASONS

8. **Point no.1:-** PW1 has filed affidavit in lieu of chief examination and deposed in line with the petition averments. He produced documents marked at Ex.P1 and Ex.P2. Ex.P1 is the non-

availability certificate issued by Respondent, and Ex.P-2 is the Pan Card. The above said oral and documentary evidence corroborates the claim of PW-1 about date of birth and its non-entry in the concerned register. Thus, he has discharged the initial burden placed on him.

9. In spite of service of notice to the Respondent, he has not appeared and contested the claim of PW-1. Hence, the say of PW-1 has gone unchallenged. Even otherwise the oral and documentary evidence produced by the Petitioner proves the date of birth and its non-registration in the concerned register. No reason is made out to disbelieve the assertion of PW-1. Further it is important to note that in the decision reported in ILR 2003 page No.4878 Hon'ble S.C. has held that death or birth event prior to 1969 enactment can be registered by the order of the court. Hence, a direction is necessary to be issued to the Respondent to register the date of birth of the Petitioner in the concerned register, or else he will be put to great hardship. Hence, **Point No.1 is answered in the Affirmative.**

10. **Point no.2:** - In view of the above discussion, the following:

ORDER

The petition filed U/sec 13(3) of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, is hereby allowed.

The respondent is directed to enter the date of birth of petitioner namely Bansilal S/o Dhattaprasad Mishra, on 12-10-1965 at Shrichand Village, Tq: Aland, Dist: Kalaburagi, Now present Tq. Kamalapur in the concerned records and issue Birth

Certificate to the petitioner after collecting prescribed fees.

It is clarified that this order shall not be conclusive proof regarding date of birth of petitioner namely Bansilal S/o Dhattaprasad Mishra, on 12-10-1965 at Shrichand Village, Tq: Aland, Dist: Kalaburagi, Now present Tq. Kamalapur if it is disputed in any civil or criminal proceedings.

No order as to costs.
