

**ORDER**

The advocate for petitioner No.1 has filed an application under section 144 of BNSS filed interim application praying to grant monthly monetary benefit of Rs.5,000/- per month to the petitioner No.1 and Rs.5,000/- each to petitioner No.2 and 3 from respondent.

2. The petitioner No.1 contended in the application that the respondent is the husband of petitioner No.1. The respondent by doing Mestry Works and his monthly income is not less than of Rs.60,000/- per month. Hence, prays to direct the respondent to pay the interim monetary benefit of Rs.5,000/- per month to the petitioner No.1 and Rs.5,000 jointly to petitioner No.2 and 3 from respondent.

3. Heard and perused the case records.

4. I have gone through the entire pleadings and documents on record. In this case, the petitioner No.1 has produced copies of Aadhaar Cards and Photos and except that they have not submitted any documentary evidence to show monthly income of respondent. Prima facie shows that as there is no dispute about relationship. Hence, at this stage, the Court cannot go into the details and it is matter to be dealt after the evidence. Therefore, in view of the relationship between the parties, it is the bounden duty of the respondent to maintain the petitioners. Hence, the petitioners are entitled for interim maintenance. It is important to note that the respondent is very much financially able to prove the maintenance. Therefore, I am of the opinion that, looking to the facts and circumstance of

the case and financial condition of both the parties, it is just and proper to award interim maintenance of Rs.2,000/- per month to the petitioner No.1 and Rs.1,500/-each to petitioners No.2 and 3 from respondent till further orders. In that event, no hardship and injustice would be caused to both the parties. Hence, I proceed to pass the following;

**ORDER**

The application filed under section 144 of of BNSS by the petitioner No.1 is hereby allowed in part.

The respondent is directed to pay the interim maintenance of Rs.2,000/- per month to the petitioner No.1 and Rs.1,500/- to petitioners No.2 and 3 from the date of this order till further order.
