**State by Aland P.S. V/s Iranna & Others.**

**CHARGE**

**I, SMT.SUMAN CHITARGI. B.com., LL.M.,** Prl. Civil Judge & JMFC, Aland, do hereby charge you:

- 1. Iranna S/o Shivasharanappa Shilavant, Age: 48 years, Occ: Business, R/o Rudrawadi, Tq: Aland.**
- 2. Akbar Ali S/o Jajar Ali Khan, Age: 48 years, Occ: Agriculture, R/o Rudrawadi, Tq: Aland.**
- 3. Vaijanath S/o Gurubasappa Wade, Age: 49 years, Occ: Business, R/o Khajuri, Tq: Aland.**

That you on 26.07.2023 at about 9.30 P.M. in the house bearing No.2/76 situated at Rudrawadi village, which comes within the jurisdiction of Aland Police Station, you accused No.1 without having any valid licence or permit from the concerned department found having illegal possession of duly filled Gas cylinders in the shutter, which was owned and possessed by you accused No.2 and use to

sell the same by you accused No.3 to the intending customers for higher prices knowing well that the gas cylinders are meant for Domestic use purpose and which are comes under essential commodities with an intention to have a wrongful gain and also against the Liquifide Petroleum Gas Supply & Control and thereby committed an offence punishable under Sec. 3, 4, 6 & 7 of Essential Commodities Act and within my cognizance.

That you on the above said date, time and place the accused No.1 found illegal possession of filled Domestic Gas Cylinders stored in the house of accused No.2 and used to sell the same to the intending purchasers for higher price with negligent conduct in respect to fire are combustible matter by dealing with the Domestic cylinders without having valid authorization and thereby committed by offence P/U/sec. 285 of IPC and within my cognizance.

And I hereby direct that, you be tried for the said offences.
