Perusal of file reveals that Proclamation under Section 82 of Cr.P.C. of accused Ismtia Bisht has already been received back duly executed to be executed on 20.06.2026. Statement of serving official is also recorded. As statutory period of 30 days have been elapsed, but accused Ismtia Bisht did not put her appearance despite elapse of said period of 30 days. As such, accused Ismtia Bisht is hereby declared proclaimed person. Intimation in this regard be also given to SHO of concerned Police Station to initiate proceedings against accused Ismtia Bisht as per law.

Complainant also suffered a statement as CW1 by stating that the evidence led by him i.e. preliminary evidence be read as part of evidence under Section 299 of Cr.P.C. on his behalf and he also close the evidence under Section 299 of Cr.P.C. on his behalf. Further he has no knowledge of property of accused. He further stated that as and when he will be able to trace the property of accused, then he will moved an application for attachment of his properties.

Statement recorded. It be also taken on record.

The present file be consigned to the record room and will be revived as and when either the accused surrenders in the court or produced by the police. Separate proceedings under Section 83 Cr.P.C will be initiated against the accused as and when, the prosecution files list of property of accused before the court.
