The plaintiffs have filed the present application for production of the documents.

2. The plaintiffs have contended that, the defendant No-4 and 5 have denied the case of the plaintiffs that, the suit properties are the ancestral properties. The plaintiffs have produced the documents in support of their case to show that, the suit properties are the ancestral properties. On the said material grounds the plaintiffs have prayed for allowing present application.

3. The defendant No-4 has filed objections to the present application by denying the grounds of the application. The defendant No-4 has contended that, the plaintiffs have not shown any grounds as to why they have not produced the said documents at the time of filing the suit. The plaintiffs have created the documents. The plaintiffs have not explained the delay in producing the documents. On the said material grounds the defendant No-4 has prayed for rejection of the present application.

4. The advocate for the defendant No-5 submitted no objections to the present application. The other defendants have not filed any objections to the present application.

5. Heard the arguments.

6. Perused the records the plaintiffs have filed the present suit for the relief of partition and separate possession against the defendants. The plaintiffs have filed the present application at the stage of the plaintiff evidence. The plaintiffs have produced the documents in the form of RTC and mutation extract documents in support of their case. Hence on considering the nature of the suit and grounds of the application and stage of the case and in order to give an opportunity to the plaintiffs to put forth their case on merits the present application is required to be allowed. Hence I am of the opinion that, the plaintiffs have made out grounds for allowing the present application.

Hence, the I.A.No-6 filed by the plaintiffs is hereby
allowed.
