ORDER ON I.A.NO-I FILED UNDER SECTION 13(B) OF
HINDU MARRIAGE ACT.

The petitioner No-1 and 2 have jointly filed the present application for dispensing the waiting period of six months for a decree of divorce by mutual consent.

2. The applicants/petitioner No.1 and 2 have contended that, their marriage was solemnized on 10-06-2011. They led a married life for sometimes. From last 5 years they are residing separately and there is no any cohabitation between them. The efforts made by the well wishers, elders and parents for re-union is not successful. They have no any issues. The petitioner No.1 and 2 have decided to separate

from each other legally. On the said material grounds the applicants have prayed for allowing the present application.

3. Heard the arguments.

4. On perusal of the records it appears that, the petitioner No-1 and 2 have jointly filed the present petition for a divorce by mutual consent. Both the parties reported solemnization of their marriage on 10-06-2011. They further reported that they have led a happy married life for sometime after their marriage. They further reported that, they are residing separately from last 5 years and they have no any issues. The efforts of the elders are not successful for their re-union. Both the parties appears to be filed the joint petition for mutual consent. Hence, on considering the grounds made out by both parties and considering joint petition filed by the parties I am of the opinion that, the applicants have made out grounds for allowing the present application. On considering the facts and circumstances of the case in the interest of both the parties I

am of the opinion that the present application is required to be allowed.

Hence, the application filed by the applicants/petitioner No-1 and 2 is hereby allowed.
