

ORDER

The plaintiff has filed the application under order 39 rule 1 and 2 of CPC with a prayer to pass an ex parte ad-interim order of temporary injunction against the defendant No.15 from alienating the suit property bearing survey No.142/4 measuring 5 acre 14 gunta of land pending disposal of the suit.

2. It is the case of the plaintiff that the plaintiff and the defendant No.1 to 14 are the joint family members. The plaintiff has got a share in the suit properties. The suit properties are ancestral and joint family properties of the plaintiff and defendant No.1 to 14. The defendant No.15 is the purchaser of the property and the defendant No.15 is now trying to alienate some of the the suit properties by taking undue advantage of the records in his name.

3. Heard the arguments and perused the materials on record.

4. On going through the materials at this stage it appears that plaintiff is claiming her share in the suit properties. Hence on considering the allegations made by the plaintiff and considering the materials on record at this stage in order to avoid multiplicity of

proceedings this court is of the opinion that the plaintiff has made out grounds for passing an interim order in her favour on IA No.I.

Hence I proceed to pass the following...

O R D E R

The defendant No.15 is hereby restrained by an order of ex parte temporary injunction from alienating the suit schedule property bearing survey No.142/4 till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff is hereby directed to comply the order as per order 39 rule 3(a) of CPC without fail.

Issue suit summons to defendant No.1 to 15 and notice of IA No.I to the defendant No.15.
