- 3] Whether the plaintiffs prove that the agreement of sale executed by the defendant No.1 and 2 in

favour of the defendant No.3 is not binding on the plaintiffs ?

- 4] Whether the defendant No.3 proves that the defendant No.2 is the absolute owner of the suit item No.1 property bearing survey No.46/5 ?
- 5] Whether the defendant No.3 proves that the defendant No.1 and 2 have executed an agreement of sale in favour of the defendant No.3 for their family and legal necessities and to clear the debts of the family ?
- 6] Whether the plaintiffs prove that they have got share in the suit properties ? if so to what extent ?
- 7] Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the reliefs claimed by them in the plaint ?
- 8] What order or decree ?
