- 1] Whether the plaintiff proves that, she is the legally wedded wife of the deceased Baburao Bandagar ?
- 2] Whether the plaintiff proves that, the suit properties were belonging to her husband i.e., deceased Baburao and she has got share in the suit properties ?

- 3] Whether the plaintiff proves that, the registered partition deed dated 23-11-2023 is null and void and not binding on the rights of the plaintiff ?
- 4] Whether the defendants prove that, one Janabai is the first wife of the deceased Baburao and the deceased Baburao married with the plaintiff during the subsistence of the marriage with the Janabai ?
- 5] Whether the defendants prove that, the suit item No-I, J, K, L and M properties bearing survey No-385 are the self acquired properties of the defendant No-1, 3 and 5 and the same are acquired by them under a registered will deed dated 20-05-1998 ?
- 6] Whether the defendants prove that, the suit item No-E, F and G properties bearing survey No-259 are the self acquired properties of the defendant No-1, 3 and 5 and

the same are acquired by them from one Vithal S/o Sidramappa ?

- 7] Whether the defendants prove that, the description of the suit properties are not correct ?
- 8] Whether the defendants prove that, the deceased Baburao has executed a registered partition deed in their favor on 23-11-2023 ?
- 9] Whether the defendants prove that, the valuation of the suit made by the plaintiff and the court fee paid by the plaintiff are not proper and correct ?
- 10] Whether the plaintiff proves that, she is entitled for the share in the suit properties ? If so to what extent ?
- 11] Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the reliefs claimed by her in the plaint ?
