- 3] Whether the plaintiff proves that, the sale deed executed by the defendant No-1 in favour of the defendant No-4 dated 27-01-2022 with respect to

the suit property is not binding on the share of the plaintiff ?

- 4] Whether the defendant No-4 proves that, the defendant No-1 has sold the suit property to the defendant No-4 to meet the family and legal necessities of the family of the plaintiff and defendant No-1 to 3 and in order to meet the expenses of marriage of the plaintiff and defendant No-2 and 3 ?
- 5] Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the share in the suit property ? If so to what extent ?
- 6] Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the reliefs claimed by her in the plaint ?
- 7] What order or decree ?
