The plaintiff has filed the present application for amendment of the plaint.

2. The plaintiff has contended that, the plaintiff has filed the suit for the relief of recovery of money against the defendant. The defendant has approached the plaintiff for the loan amount of Rs.6,50,000/- at Havalaga Village. Due to over sight the place of transaction is not mentioned in the plaint to show the territorial jurisdiction of the court. The plaintiff is intended to amend the plaint. On the said material grounds the plaintiff has prayed for allowing the present application.

5. Perused the records the plaintiff has filed the present suit for the recovery of money. The plaintiff by way of amendment intended to insert the place of transaction for the purpose of territorial jurisdiction of the court. Hence considering the grounds of the application and materials on
