- 1] Whether the plaintiff proves that, the plaintiff and the defendants are the Hindu joint family members ?
- 2] Whether the plaintiff proves that, the suit properties are the joint family properties of the plaintiff and the defendants ?

- 3] Whether the plaintiff proves that, the gift deeds executed by the defendant No-1 in favour of the defendant No-2 to 4 are not binding on the plaintiff ?
- 4] Whether the plaintiff proves that, the defendant No-2 to 4 have no any right in the suit properties and the plaintiff and the defendant No-1 and the defendant No-5 are only entitled for 1/3rd share each in the suit properties ?
- 5] Whether the defendant No-1 to 4 prove that, the suit item No-2 property bearing survey number 12/1 and suit item No-4 property bearing survey number 66/2 are the self acquired properties of the defendant No-1 ?
- 6] Whether the defendant No-1 to 4 prove the oral partition in the family and allotment of survey number 66/7 measuring 3 acre 38 gunta of land and survey number 61/6 measuring 1 acre 11 gunta of land to the share of

the plaintiff as contended by them in their written statement ?

- 7] Whether the defendant No-1 to 4 prove that, the suit of the plaintiff is bad for non-inclusion of all the family properties?
- 8] Whether the plaintiff proves that, he is entitled for the share in the suit properties ? If so to what extent ?
- 9] Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the reliefs claimed by him in the plaint ?
- 10] What Order or Decree ?
