- 3] Whether the defendant No-2 to 10 prove the prior partition between the parties as contended by them in their written statement ?

- 4] Whether the defendant No-2 to 10 prove that, the plaintiff and the defendant No-2 have exchanged their properties and the plaintiff has relinquished his rights in 7 acre 10 gunta of land in survey number 31 in favour of the defendant No-2 and sold the properties fallen to his share as contended by them in their written statement ?
- 5] Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the share in the suit property ? If so to what extent ?
- 6] Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the reliefs claimed by his in the plaint ?
- 7] What Order or Decree ?
