

ORDER

The plaintiffs have filed the application under order 39 rule 1 and 2 of CPC with a prayer to pass an ex parte ad-interim order of temporary injunction against the defendants from alienating the suit property pending disposal of the suit.

It is the case of the plaintiffs that the plaintiffs are the owners of 4 acre of land in the suit property and the defendants are interfering in the land of the plaintiffs. The defendants are now trying to alienate the suit property by taking undue advantage of the records in their name.

Heard the arguments and perused the materials on record.

On going through the materials at this stage it appears that plaintiffs are claiming their rights in the suit property. Hence on considering the allegations made by the plaintiffs and considering the materials on record at this stage in order to avoid multiplicity of proceedings this court is of the opinion that the plaintiffs have made out grounds for passing an interim order in their favour on IA No.I.

Hence I proceed to pass the following...

ORDER

The defendants are hereby restrained by an order of ex parte temporary injunction from alienating the suit schedule property till next date of hearing.

The plaintiffs are hereby directed to comply the order as per order 39 rule 3(a) of CPC without fail.

Issue notice of IA No.I and suit summons to defendant No. 1 (a) to (c) and defendant No.2 to 4.
