

**Order sheet of Proceedings before

1. Counsel for the Plaintiff present and RB counsel for the defendants is present filed power on behalf of Defendant No.1 to 6.

2. Plaintiff and defendants are present. After negotiation parties agreed to settle the matter voluntarily. Accordingly the parties to the suit filed compromise petition U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC.

3. The terms of compromise petition which are in English language are read over to the parties. Having understood the terms of compromise petition, the parties submits that they are ready to compromise the matter as per the terms of the compromise petition. The parties submits that they are willingly and voluntarily compromising the matter and there is no threat or force from anyone.
