Chief examination by V.R.M.

1. I am working as Medical officer in Kural Hospital Kalaburagi. I have received summons from the court to produce the documents. As per the order of the court I am producing the register maintained by the hospital. I have produced the M.L.C register, MLC intimation, Case sheet of patient. The documents are marked as Ex.R-1 to R3.

Cross Examination: Sri. VVC

1. I have given first aid treatment to the injured and referred him for consultation to the specialist. I have given MLC intimation in this case. I identify Ex.R2. It is true to suggest that in Ex.R2 the date of issuance is mentioned as 11-06-2021. It is true to

suggest that in Ex.R2 the date of receipt of intimation by the concerned police station is not mentioned. As per Ex.R2 I have informed to WPC by name Shilpa of Chincholi police station through Telephonic message. The number of telephone is not mentioned in Ex.R2. In the Ex.R1 to R3 the history of the injury is written as road traffic accident. I work as medical officer in 2-3 hospitals. It is true to suggest there is government guidelines for intimation of MLC. It is true to suggest that there are different types of RTA. In this case the mode of RTA of injured is not mentioned. A person by name Nagesh had accompanied injured to the Hospital. As per our records the injured had narrated us that he had directly come to our hospital after accident. I do not remember if injured or Nagesh narrated us that he had directly come to our hospital after accident. It is true to suggest that after issuance of MLC intimation, to the police collect the document. The witness further volunteers that after giving MLC intimation I have referred the patient to the further treatment. It is false to suggest that with an intention to help the petitioner to get false compensation, I have not mentioned the original history of accident.

Cross Examination: Sri. NHR

1. It is true that we do not have any records to show that prior to coming to our hospital, the injured has taken treatment at some other hospital.
