

**ORDER ON IA No.III U/o 6 Rule 17 of CPC.**

The decree holder has filed this application U/o 6 Rule 17 of CPC and sought for amend the petition.

The Dhr has sworn to an affidavit in support the IA and stated that in the petition due to typing mistake it is mention that "after receiving" instead of "already received at the time of compromise".
