

Order on IA-I filed U/o 39 Rule 1 & 2 of CPC by the plaintiffs

1. This is an interlocutory application No I filed by the plaintiffs seeking for temporary injunction order restraining them or their men or agent the defendants from alienating, mortgaging or creating charge over the suit properties in any manner till disposal of the suit.

2. The interim application is accompanied with an affidavit sworn by the plaintiffs wherein she has sworn that, she had filed the suit seeking the relief of Declaration of ownership and permanent injunction in respect of suit schedule properties. It is stated by the plaintiffs that the defendants trying to alienate the suit schedule property to others. If the defendants are permitted to alienate the suit schedule property, then the plaintiffs will suffer irreparable loss which cannot be compensated in terms of money or otherwise. Thus the plaintiffs sought for the relief of ex parte ad interim injunction order as against the defendants in the application.

3. Heard and perused the entire materials on record. Perused the affidavit of the application and the plaint averments. On perusal of the documents produced by the plaintiffs i.e., the record of rights of suit schedule properties depicts the name of defendants shows that the plaintiffs has prima-facie case. Thus on perusal of the plaint averments, affidavit and documents it shows that the plaintiffs has made out prima-facie materials to grant ad interim ex parte injunction order. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Issue an ad interim injunction order against
the defendants restraining the defendants from

alienating the suit properties in any manner either by sale, mortgage or creating charge till next date of hearing.

Plaintiffs to comply with the provisions of Order 39 Rule 3 of Civil Procedure Code,1908.

Issue notice to defendants on I.A.No I and suit summons if process is complied with.
