

**Order sheet of proceedings before National Lok-adalath held on 14-03-2026**

Case is called before Lok-adalath.

1. Petitioners and their counsel are present.

The learned counsel for the petitioners filed memo.

It is stated that the petitioners and respondent No.2 are ready to compromise the matter. In view of contents of memo, I proceed to pass the following.

**ORDER**

1. Petition is dismissed against respondent No.1 in terms of memo.

2. petitioners and his counsel are present.

After negotiation parties agreed to settle the matter voluntarily. Accordingly the petitioners and the respondent No.2 filed joint memo.

3. The terms of joint memo which are in English language are read over to the parties. Having understood terms of joint memo, the parties further submits that they are ready to compromise the matter as per the terms of the

joint memo. As per the terms of joint memo the respondent No.2 company has agreed to pay and settle the claim for **Rs.18,00,000/- (Eighteen Lakh Rupees only)** towards full and final settlement. Further the parties submits that they are willingly and voluntarily compromising the matter and there is no threat or force from any one.

4. The claim petition is for compensation for the death of son of Petitioner No.1 and 2 and brother of Petitioner No.3 in road traffic accident. The terms of joint memo are acceptable and there are no legal impediments in accepting the joint memo and the joint memo is not against to the principles of natural justice and public policy. The parties have put their signatures/thumb-impression on the compromise petition and also produced the xerox copies of their identity cards. The same is verified with the original identity cards of the parties. The Respondent No.2

company has compromised with the petitioners by paying compensation of **Rs.18,00,000/- (Eighteen Lakh Rupees only)** and petitioner agreed to receive the same. Hence Joint memo is accepted. Petition filed by the petitioners is allowed in terms of the joint memo. Respondent No.2 is directed to deposit the entire amount of **Rs.18,00,000/- (Eighteen Lakh Rupees only)** as per the terms agreed in joint memo.

5. The petitioner No.1 to 3 are equally entitled for compensation amount.

6. Office is directed to release entire amount to the petitioners after due verification.

7. Office is directed to draw an award in terms of the joint memo.
