

ORDER ON I.A. NO. I FILED BY THE PLAINTIFF
UNDER ORDER XXXIX RULE 1 AND 2 OF CPC.

The plaintiff has filed the I.A.No.I U/Order XXXIX Rules 1 & 2 of CPC with a prayer, ex-parte Temporary Injunction (TI) order, be granted against the defendant No.1 from any kind of correction of ROR, alienating mortgaging and creating any kind of charge over the suit schedule properties in any manner, till disposal of the suit.

2. In support of the above said I.A., the plaintiff has sworn an affidavit. The plaintiff has filed this suit for the reliefs of partition and separate possession against defendants.

3. The plaintiff has produced the copy of ROR of land Sy.No. 13 for the year 2021-22 and 2024-25, copy of ROR of land Sy.No. 14 for the year 2021-22 and 2024-25, attested copy of Aadhar card of the plaintiff. In the ROR of the 2021-22 of Sy.No. 13 and

14 the name of the Gouramma W/o Rachappa Padashetty appears. After perusal of the contents of I.A.No.I, affidavit and documents produced by the plaintiff, at this juncture, the plaintiff has made out the prima-facie grounds to grant Ex-parte temporary injunction as prayed, but till next date of hearing. If temporary injunction is not granted, plaintiff will suffer inconvenience & hardship. Hence, this court inclined to pass the following order:

ORDER

Issue ex-parte temporary injunction order against the defendant No.1, restraining him from alienating the suit schedule properties in any manner, till next date of hearing.

Issue notice of Ex-parte Temporary Injunction order along with suit summons and emergent notice of I.A. to the defendant No.1, if plaintiff complies the provisions of Order XXXIX Rule 3(a) and (b) of CPC. Further issue suit summons to the defendant No.2.
