2. Whether plaintiffs further prove that they are absolute owners of the suit land?
3. Whether plaintiffs further prove that they are in peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit land as on the date of filing the suit?
4. Whether plaintiffs further prove that the alleged interference and obstruction by the defendants over the suit property?
5. Whether plaintiffs further prove that the defendant No.1 is not the legally wedded wife of late Chandrama @ Chandrasha and has illegal rights in any manner over the suit property?
6. Whether plaintiffs further prove that the defendant No.1 is a Devadasi Woman and she has got married with one Dharmanna?

7. Whether defendant No.1 proves that she is the legally wedded wife of the deceased Chandram @ Chandrasha and her name is entered in the office of Provident Fund and Service Records as nominee during the lifetime of deceased Chandram @ Chandrasha?
8. Whether defendant No.1 further proves that the suit is not properly valued and court fee paid by the plaintiff is insufficient, hence suit is hit by under Order VII Rule 11 of CPC?
9. Whether plaintiffs are entitled to the reliefs as sought for?
10. What decree or order?
