

ORDER

This is a suit filed by the plaintiff for the relief of permanent injunction against the defendant, along with suit plaintiff has filed I.A.No.I U/O 39 R 1 & 2 of CPC and prayed for Ex-parte TI against the defendant restraining him from dismantling the boundary wall situated in between the suit land of plaintiff bearing Sy.No.73 and land of defendant Sy.No.88/5 pending disposal of this suit.

Heard and perused the IA-I affidavits and other documents produced by the plaintiff along with the suit.

I have carefully perused the entire records on hand, at this stage, on perusal of the documents and other material on hand, it is found that, in between the lands of plaintiff and defendant their exist a boundary wall and if the defendant dismantle the said wall it will cause injustice and hardship to the plaintiff. Therefore, I am of the opinion that, the plaintiff has made out sufficient and reasonable grounds for grant of exparte TI and if Ex-parte T.I. is not granted, the plaintiff will be put to irreparable loss and hardship. Hence, I am of the opinion, it is necessary to issue exparte T.I. Hence, notice dispensed. The defendant or anybody claiming through him are hereby restrained by way of Ad-Interim temporary injunction from dismantling the boundary wall of suit property as described in the plaint para-2 in any manner until next date of hearing.

The plaintiff is directed to comply the procedure as contemplated U/O 39 Rule 3 of CPC.

Issue T.I. order and notice on IA-I to and suit summons to defendant, if compliance made and proper PF is paid.
