1. Whether the plaintiff proves that she is the absolute owner of the suit property?
2. Whether plaintiff further proves that she is in peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit property as on date of filing of the suit?
3. Whether plaintiff further proves that the alleged interference by the defendants over the suit property?
4. Whether plaintiff further proves that the defendants have taken up construction ill-legally over the suit property as described in para No 2 of the plaint?
5. Whether defendants prove that the ancestors of the plaintiff's husband donated 5 guntas of land from suit property to one Veerbhadrappa great grand father of defendant about 100 years ago but in the panchayat records 10 guntas of land i.e., suit property was standing in the name of Sadashivappagouda?

6. Whether defendants further prove that with a permission of the ancestor of the plaintiff's husband the said Veerbhadrappa put up a hut over the suit property for his family to live in as their permanent place of residence and since then they are in possession of the 5 guntas of land from suit property?

7. Whether plaintiff is entitled to the reliefs as sought for?

8. What decree or order?
