

Case called out.

Counsel for the plaintiff present.

Heard the counsel for the plaintiff on I.A. No.I. under Order 32 Rule 3 of CPC.

The plaintiff has filed this suit for the relief of partition and separate possession and perpetual injunction against the defendants.

The IA.No.1 is filed Under Order 32 Rule 15 of CPC for appointing Defendant No.1 & 3 as a minor guardian of Defendant No.2 & 4 to 7.

In the affidavit it is stated that, the defendant No.2 is minor under guardianship of the defendant No.1 and defendant No.4 to 7 are minors under guardianship of their natural mother defendant No.3, defendant No.2 and 4 to 7 are not able to understand things and independently he cannot deal with any work on this own without the assistance of any others persons as such he is unable to protect his interest. Therefore, suit is filed by the plaintiff through the guardianship of the defendant No.1 and 3, they are the proper person to act as guardian and they have no adverse interest against the plaintiff. Hence, prayed to allow application.

Perused the plaint averments and other relevant documents. The defendant No.2 and 4 to 7 are minors, hence it is just and necessary to appoint the defendant No.1 & 3 as minor guardian



of defendants and permit sue against the defendants. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

IA.No.I is hereby allowed.

Acting under Order 32 Rule 3 of CPC, the defendant No.1 is hereby appointed as minor guardian of the defendant No.2. Further the defendant No.3 is hereby appointed as minor guardian of defendant No.4 to 7 as sought for.
