Issue No.3. Whether defendants prove that, deceased Mallappa had two wives 1st wife is Bheemawwa and 2nd wife Bheemabai and deceased Yamunappa is the S/o of Bheemawwa and they are the L.R's of deceased Mallappa ?

Issue No.4. Whether defendants proves that, Bheemabai is the 2nd wife of deceased Mallappa and plaintiff are the daughters of deceased Bheemabai and they have no right in the suit schedule properties ?

The admission made by the respondent prima-facie discloses that, he is having some source of income to maintain his wife and he is having capacity to give interim maintenance to the petitioners. The matter before the Court takes it own time for the final disposal of the case and till then the petitioner herein requires money for her livelihood and proceed with the case. Hence the following:

ORDER

The respondent is directed to pay Rs.1500/- pm to the petitioner No.1 and Rs.1000/- pm to the petitioner No.2 as interim maintenance till the disposal of the main petition.
