2. Whether plaintiffs further proves that sale deed dated 27-03-2018 executed by defendant No.1 in favour of defendant No.2 is illegal, invalid and not binding on them?
3. Whether defendant No.2 proves that suit is bad for non joinder of necessary parties?
4. Whether defendant No.2 further proves that suit property was the self acquired property of defendant No.1 namely Amalappa S/o Basanna?
5. Whether defendant No.2 further proves that suit is bad for non inclusion of all the other family properties in one hotchpot?
6. Whether defendant No.2 further proves that defendant No.1 alienated the suit property in order to discharge his family legal necessities?
7. Whether defendant No.2 further proves that suit is barred by limitation?
8. Whether plaintiffs are entitled for the reliefs as sought for in plaint?
