- 1. Whether the plaintiff proves that plaintiff and defendants No.1 and 2 are the members of joint Hindu family and the suit schedule properties are the joint family and ancestral properties of them?**
- 2. Whether the plaintiff proves that the properties (Item No.2 to 4) excluding (Sy.No.95 measuring 6 acres 22 guntas are the properties purchased out of the income derived from the ancestral properties and the plaintiff assisted his brother to purchase other lands?**
- 3. Whether the defendants prove that partition was effected in the year 2006?**

- 4. Whether the defendants prove that land bearing Sy.No.74 measuring 11 acres 35 guntas situated at Gangawarpalli, Tq: Sedam was purchased by late Buggayya S/o Kashmirayya Kalal which his own independent funds through registered sale deed dated 23.11.1981?**
  
- 5. Whether the defendants prove that Buggayya had two wives by name Padmamma and Mahadevamma and kept defendant No.2 who is the daughter of plaintiff with him in his house?**
  
- 6. Whether the defendants prove that Buggayya mutated the 6 acres in the name of defendant No.1 and 5 acres 24 guntas in the name of Mahadevamma in Sy.No.74 totally measuring 11 acres 24 guntas?**
  
- 7. Whether the defendants prove that Buggayya was the absolute owner of land bearing Sy.No.90 measuring 7 acres 8 guntas situated at Garampalli village, Tq: Sedam through registered sale deed dated 27.4.1982 and after the death of Buggayya the defendant No.1 is the sole owner and in possession of the said land?**

8. Whether the defendants prove that Buggayya purchased the land bearing Sy.No.93 measuring 12 acres 12 guntas situated at Garampalli village, Tq: Sedam through registered sale deed dated 20.5.1985 and gave it defendant No.1 and defendant No.1 is the sole owner and in possession of the said land?
9. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the reliefs sought for?
10. What order or decree?
