

**Orders on IA U/O 13 Rule 10 of CPC**

The respondent has filed this application U/O 13 Rule 10 of CPC and sought to summon the salary certificate of the petitioner from the CDPO, Sedam.

**2.** The respondent has sworn to an affidavit in support of IA and stated that the petitioner is working as Anganwadi teacher and getting salary and to prove the same the Salary certificate of the petitioner is necessary. Hence, prays to allow the IA.

**3.** The petitioner has filed objections to IA and submitted that the petitioner is getting honourary payment for her service as Anganawadi Sahayaki. She is not a salaried employee. Hence prays to dismiss the IA.

**4.** Perused the records. Heard arguments.

**5.** The petitioner has filed this petition seeking divorce and during pendency of the petition she has filed IA U/s.24 of Hindu Marriage Act seeking interim maintenance. It is the contention of the respondent that the petitioner is working as Anganawadi Teacher and she is having sufficient income. Therefore, in order to decide the quantum of income of the petitioner the Salary certificate is very much required. Further the petitioner has contended that she is serving as Anganwadi helper and getting honourary payment and she is not salaried employee. Therefore, she does not have salary certificate. It is to be noted that if the CDPO is summoned then only this court will come to

know that whether Salary certificate can be issued or not. Therefore, at this stage the contention of the petitioner cannot be accepted. Hence, the following:

**ORDER**

The application filed by the respondent U/O 13 Rule 10 of CPC is hereby allowed.

The CDPO, Sedam is hereby summoned to produce Salary Certificate of the petitioner viz Laxmi W/o Hanamappa, R/o Rudrawar, Post: Chitaknapalli, Tq: Sedam who is working as Anganwadi Sahayaki in Rudrawar village.

Office to issue witness summons to CDPO Sedam.
