- 3. Whether the plaintiff proves that the registered Gift deed dated 9.12.2022 is null and void and not binding on the rights of the plaintiff?**
- 4. Whether the plaintiff proves that the registered Gift deed dated 24.8.2023 is null and void and not binding on the rights of the plaintiff?**
- 5. Whether the defendants 1 and 5 prove that the mother of plaintiff and defendants 1 to 3 by name Nagamani**

purchased 6 acres 25 guntas in Sy.No.827/2 with the assistance of her maternal family and hence the said property is self acquired property of the said Nagamani?

- 6. Whether the defendants 1 and 5 prove that the said Nagamani gifted the land measuring 3 acres 29 guntas in Sy.No.827/2 in favour of defendant No.5 through registered Gift deed dated 23.8.2023?**
- 7. Whether the defendants 1 and 5 prove that the suit is one for partial partition and hence the same is not maintainable?**
- 8. Whether the defendants 1 and 5 proved that suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties?**
- 9. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the reliefs prayed foregoing**
- 10. What order or decree?**
