**ORDER**

The petitioners have filed an application for grant of interim maintenance of Rs.20,000/- per month to the petitioners from the respondent.

2. The petitioner No.1 in her affidavit enclosed with the instant application contended that, the petitioner after marriage started staying at her matrimonial home at Hyderabad with the respondent. That in marriage parents of the petitioner have incurred huge expenses for performing marriage i.e. more than 5,00,000/- apart from this they have given the cash of Rs. 1,00,000/- and two Tola Gold and valuable house articles, furniture, Sofa set, Palang and cooler etc. Further contended that, the respondent treated to the petitioner properly for a period of a 3 years thereafter he started mal-treating the petitioner by finding fault in a day to day work for trivial reasons and started to abuse in filthy language and were saying that petitioners parents did not teach to work properly and also demanding to bring Rs. 2,00,000/- as a dowry otherwise not reside in their house and were assaulting with hands very now and then, and threatened by saying that she should leave their house on her own accord or else he will be detained in the bathroom. Thereafter, petitioner gave birth to two children by name Md Ziyah Shah and Safia Bee Darvesh, Thereafter, respondent started to force the plaintiff to do the stitching work

which was refused by the petitioner because she did not know the skill of tailoring and petitioner informed the same fact to her parents and elders and they advised the respondent to treat the petitioner in proper manner, but the respondent continued to harass and torture the petitioner. Thereafter on 12.12.2024 petitioner gave birth to one girl child in her parental home and after knowing at the girl child the respondent refused to accept the girl child in his home and informed the petitioner to not to bring girl child to his home otherwise he would kill both of them. Thereafter the petitioner informed the same to her parents and her parents visited the respondent's house on 22.08.2025 on the refusal of the respondent they took the petitioner to their house. Now the petitioner No.1 is living at her parental house with petitioner No.2 and 3. Though petitioner's parents requested many times the respondent did not take the petitioners back to their house. The petitioner is a unskilled Pardanashin lady and not having any source of income and she unable to maintain herself and petitioner No.2 and 3 and parents of the petitioner No.1 are also aged persons and her father also suffering from age based illness therefore they are unable to maintain the petitioner No.1 to 3. The respondent is a hale, healthy and good earning person as he is a driver and he is earnings daily Rs. 2000/- to 3000/- and having sufficient means to provide maintenance to the petitioner No.1 to 3. Even though he had neglected the petitioner to provide food, cloth, shelter and medical expenses.

3. I have gone through the entire pleadings and the contents of affidavit accompanied with the instant application. The documents on record at this stage, the documents produced by the petitioner shows that, the respondent is the husband of petitioner No.1 and he is working as a driver. By considering the facts and circumstance of the case, it is is just and necessary to pass interim maintenance order granting reasonable interim maintenance of Rs.3,000/-per month from the respondent, till pending disposal of the application.

**ORDER**

The respondent is directed to pay the interim maintenance of Rs.3,000/- per month to the petitioner NO.1 to 3 from the date of filing the petition till pending disposal of the application.

Issue Notice to respondent and intimation of interim order if PF is paid.
