Charge

I, Sri. Balu., B.A. LL.B, Civil Judge & J.M.F.C. Sedam, do hereby charge you:

As follows:

That, on 01.06.2024 at around 13.12 hrs received message from DSCR, regarding stone Pelting incident on T.No.12025 PUNE-SC Shatabdi Express between Sedam and Kurgunta Railway Stations, IPF/Vikarabad along with staff attended the affected coach on arrival of the train to Vikarabad at 13.45 hrs and ascertained the damage caused to window glass of E-1 coach, further on confidential watch in and around the alleged spot at around 21.30 hrs detained a suspected person and on enquiry in presence of mediators the accused said that, one of his knowing person is died in a road accident, due to which he was mentally disturbed and consumed alcohol. While he was walking near to the grave yard beside the Railway tracks at around 12.40 hrs he thrown a stone on glass window of the running T.No.12025 and left from the spot, later he again had consumed some more alcohol and came near to the grave yard area, beside the tracks and at around 17.40 hrs on seeing a T.No.22718 he again pelted a stone on the window glass and left from

the place and he was apprehended by RPF police.

There by you committed an offence U/sec. 153 and 147 of Railway Act and within my cognizance.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by me on the above said charge.
