- 3)** Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the gift deed dated 29.11.2003 and will dated 15.09.2008 executed by their father in favor of defendant are not binding on them?
- 4)** Whether the defendant proves that, suit is bad for non joinder of necessary party?
- 5)** Whether the defendant proves that, suit item no.2 and 3 are the self acquired properties of her father Sri.Munivenkatappa?
- 6)** Whether the defendant proves that, her father Sri.Munivenkatappa has executed registered will dated 15.09.2008 bequeathing item no.2 of the suit schedule property in her favor when he was in sound disposing state of mind?

7) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for 2/3rd share in the suit schedule properties?

8) What order or decree?
