	28.02.2023	The present anticipatory bail application preferred at the instance of accused/petitioner, namely, Dhaneshwar Ravidas, S/o Indar Ravidas, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Lawalong PS Case No. 52/2019, registered for the offence U/s 392 of IPC. The learned advocate appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioner submitted that the accused/petitioner is innocent, has not committed any crime and falsely implicated in this case. He has further submitted that the accused/petitioner is not named in the FIR and no incriminating article has been seized or recovered from his possession. There is no eye witness of the occurrence. He has further submitted that the accused/petitioner has no criminal antecedent, thus, prayed to enlarge him on anticipatory bail. On the other hand learned PP opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail and submitted that the accused/petitioner	

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	Contd P/2 28.02.2023	involved in commission of loot and during investigation involvement of accused/petitioner came in this case and investigation of the case is still pending, thus, he does not deserve anticipatory bail. Heard both sides and perused the case record. The accused/petitioner is named in the FIR of Lawalong PS Case No. 52/2019, registered for the offence U/s 392 of IPC. The brief facts of the case is that on 24.12.2019 at 06.00 PM he was returning from his Clinic from Lawalong through Lamta and in the way near Nilajan river at 06.45 PM three persons by a motorcycle on the point of arms stopped him and looted his mobile of Redmi 6 Pro, purse containing his Adhar Card, Pan Card, Driving license & Rs. 900/- cash and they also looted his Apache motorcycle bearing registration No. JH-13D-6326 on gun point and fled away, then the case was registered. From perusal of the case record it appears that through the accused/petitioner is not named in the FIR but during investigation witnesses have supported the occurrence and his name came in this case. The investigation of the case is still

Therefore, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of allegations, I am not inclined to enlarge the accused/petitioner on anticipatory bail. However, the accused/petitioner, named above, is directed to surrender before the learned court below within 03 weeks and pray for regular bail.
