

**PROCEEDINGS BEFORE NATIONAL LOK-ADALATH
HELD ON 14.09.2024.**

The case is called before the Lok Adalath. Both parties present.

The plaintiff files memo stating that she had executed a GPA in favour of her husband to conduct the case on her behalf, but he is admitted to KLE hospital Belagavi due to ill-health. Hence, she is continuing the suit on her own. Memo is accepted.

Both parties submitted that they are ready to compromise the case. Conciliation held, after due conciliation, both parties agreed to compromise the matter and filed a compromise petition under order 23 Rule 3 R/w Sec.151 of CPC along with photostat copies of Aadhaar cards and receipt for having received the amount and gold. Perused the same and the contents of the compromise petition are read over and explained to the parties in the language known to them and they have agreed and accepted the same. Compromise seems to be lawful and voluntary one. Therefore, I proceed to pass the following;
